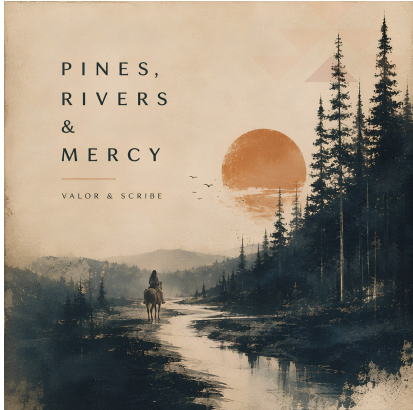


Pines, Rivers & Mercy

ABOUT THE ALBUM

Pines, Rivers & Mercy draws together Appalachian-inspired folk, country-gospel storytelling and influences gathered across decades of listening, learning and life. Acoustic guitar, fiddle, dobro, hand-drum textures and close harmonies carry songs of grief, identity, family, endurance, resurrection and the quiet presence of God. Though unmistakably Christian, the album welcomes listeners into familiar human places rather than preaching from a distance.
